OFFICIAL RULES 2010

To participate, please complete contest entry form: Identify your favorite location in Irvington to read a book and provide a brief description of why the location is so special. Personal creativity is encouraged, so entries may also include other written or graphic elements such as a poem, photograph, artwork, etc. Please make sure your name is on any additional materials.

Specify what age category you are entering: Children (up to and including age 12), Teenager (ages 13-17) or Adult (ages 18 and older).

Locations can be anywhere in the Village of Irvington: Outside, inside, public, private, library, park, home, etc.

Time frame: The contest starts June 4, 2010 and runs throughout the summer ending on August 31, 2010. Entries must be received at the Irvington Public Library by August 31, 2010 cutoff.

Number of Entries: No limit. Submissions will not be returned.

Deliver entries to: Summer Reading Box, The Irvington Public Library, 12 South Astor Street, Irvington, New York 10533. The library is open Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday 10 a.m.-5 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday 10 a.m.-9 p.m., closed Sunday. Phone: (914) 591-7840.

Judging: Entries will be judged on how best they reflect the contest theme “Irvington’s Favorite Places to Read a Book this Summer.” A panel of judges including Friends of Irvington Library Board Members will select First, Second and Third Place Winners for each category (Children, Teenager and Adult). Winners will be announced after Labor Day. The Friends of the Irvington Library will retain sole discretion to determine/disqualify any entries considered inappropriate.

Prizes: Winners will receive “Everything you need to read” prizes including: Friends of the Irvington Library backpack, bookmark, water bottle, reading light, reading diary, portable dictionary, Barnes & Noble gift check plus tickets for the 5th Annual Community-Wide Spelling Bee to be held next January.

Ownership/Use Rights: By entering, you agree to allow Friends of the Irvington Library to use submissions to promote the library (through publicity, fund-raiser, etc.).
